This event is limited to first year forensic competitors ONLY and requires the use of a manuscript. The student will present material either from prose, poetry, or a play. Children's literature is acceptable in this category. The presentation should include an introduction that cites the name(s) of the piece(s) and the author(s).. Material from more than one source is not allowed, with the exception of programs of poetry. The author's words as published in the literature may not be altered for this presentation with the exception that cutting is permitted. Speakers may not take the lines belonging to one character and apply them to a different character in the performance. No costumes or props may be used in the presentation.

Time: 10 minute maximum, including introduction (30 second grace); no minimum
